Eligibility

The following criteria must be met by the prospective ECE professional in order to qualify for the grant.

- Currently employed by and working at a Seventh-day Adventist ECEC program within the Pacific Union Conference
- Possesses a current Professional Achievement Recognition Level 2 (or above) certificate
- Aims to complete Early Childhood Education courses in order to advance to the next level of professional achievement certification (Levels 2-6), OR
- Determines to maintain professional achievement certification through professional growth workshops and/or conferences (Levels 6-7)
- Submits a completed grant application with signatures by the deadline August 1, 2018
- Provides a letter of recommendation from ECEC director (if you are an ECEC staff member), OR
- Provides a letter of recommendation from conference ECEC liaison (if you are an ECEC director)

Application Submission
