Why Plan?

- Planning provides procedures and steps:
 - Assigned duties
 - Lists of supplies
- Forms and policies:
 - Licensing forms
 - Agreements and consents
- Contacts for support:
 - Out of State contact
 - Local emergency contacts

A few things to think about:

- What are the possible emergencies – flood, fire, earthquake...
- What will you need to prepare for-shelter in place, evacuate...
- What supplies will you provide
- What supplies do you want the children to have
- What supplies do you want your teachers to have
- How and where will you store the supplies
- How will you get information to parents
